RE: REVALIDATION RESULT OF THE 2020 PERFORMANCE SCORECARD OF CITEM

Dear Secretary Pascual and ED Fereira,

This is with reference to CITEM's letter dated 18 July 2022¹ requesting for reconsideration of the following strategic measures (SMs) under the validated 2020 Performance Scorecard:

- SM 2: Budget Utilization Rate;
- SM 6: Increase Designs Developed;
- SM 8: Percentage Completion of the ISSP; and
- SM 10: Percentage of Employees Meeting the Required Competencies.

Based on the re-evaluation of the justifications and additional supporting documents relative to its request for reconsideration, the validated score of CITEM's 2020 Performance Scorecard is hereby <u>INCREASED</u> from 62.37% to **80.42%**. The review and evaluation of the documents submitted are reflected in the "Revalidation Result of the 2020 Performance Scorecard" attached as **Annex A**. The same is to be posted on CITEM's website, in accordance with Section 43 of the GCG Memorandum Circular (M.C.) No. 2012-07.²

Despite the increase in the validated score, CITEM remains to have failed to achieve the required weighted-average score of at least 90% in the 2020 Performance Scorecard, thus, remains to be ineligible to grant the 2020 Performance-Based Bonus (PBB) to its officers and employees.
