1.0 OBJECTIVE:

To seek Board approval of CITEM's Corporate Operating Budget and Work Program for FY 2014.

2.0 FACTS:

- 2.1 Initially, CITEM submitted to the DBM a Proposed Operating Budget for FY 2014 in the amount of P311.708M and requested a government subsidy of P230.728 M.
- 2.2 On 21 June 2013, CITEM was advised that the DBM recommended a subsidy level of P186.443M, or P 1.675 M less than total subsidy given in FY 2013 of P 188.118M.
- 2.3 Based on the Proposed Work Program, hereunder is the Revised Corporate Operating Budget for FY 2014:

TITLE: REVISED WORK PROGRAM AND BUDGET FOR 2014

1.0 Objectives:

To seek Board approval on the following:

- 1.1. Revised Work Program 2014
- 1.2 Supplemental Budget of P38.227 million for 2014
- 2.0 Facts:
- 2.1. For 2014, CITEM requested a subsidy of P230.728 million of which the DBM granted only P186.443 million (or P1.675million less than the P188.118 million granted in 2013. Breakdown of subsidy as advised by DBM:

2.2 CITEM revised its Work Program accordingly and adjusted its Corporate Operating Budget (COB) to P257.804 million as follows:

- 2.3 The Board approved the P257.804 million COB in a referendum dated 05 August 2013.
- 2.4 The DBM advised CITEM of an additional P4.000 million subsidy requested by Senator Loren Legarda for the continuation of the "Hibla Project" in Manila FAME, increasing subsidy from P186.443 million to P190.443 million.
- 2.5. Due to the clamor of the private sector for increased assistance in their export promotion activities, CITEM granted higher level of discounts as well as increased budget for product design development.
- 2.6. The above-action resulted to lower projected revenues in 2014, from P66.561 million to P39.697million, necessitating CITEM to use portion of its Retained Earnings to cover the shortfall in revenue.

- 2.7. The Capital Outlay of CITEM approved by the Board in 2013 in the amount of P20.000 million was not fully utilized. CITEM is therefore requesting the Board to allow usage of P15.775 million as additional Capital Outlay in 2014.
- 2.8. To be able to implement the Revised Work Program for 2014, there is a need for a supplemental budget in the amount of P38.227 million, increasing COB to P296.031 million. Breakdown of the supplemental budget:

a. Increase in MOOE

P22.452million

- Hibla Project in Manila FAME P4.000 million

-Supplemental for General Administrative Support

18.452

b. Additional Capital Outlay Budget Total

<u> 15.775</u>

<u>P38.227</u> million

Supplemental budget of P18.452 million for General Administrative Support (GAS) is requested to augment the DBM subsidy of only P14.125million. Total budget requirement for GAS should be P32.577 million.
